Eligibility criteria

1. To be eligible for the DXC Dandelion Program you must be able to meet the following criteria:

- Be aged **18 years or over**
- Provide a **written diagnosis of your autism**
- Satisfy the requirements of **employee security screening and police checks**
- Be able to attend a **one-day workshop and all of a 3-week paid assessment program**

2. The experience criteria below are highly desirable but not required:

- A tertiary qualification, preferably in a Science, Technology, Engineering or Mathematics (STEM) discipline.
- Experience in software testing, business analysis, computer programming, data analysis, networking, network security, system administration, or similar IT-oriented tasks.
- A strong interest in learning and performing IT-related tasks.

Applicant consideration

- Applicants should consider the distance and the daily commute options to and from the Melbourne Central Business District (CBD).
