


A025 All Abilities Day Ballpark Session- Prepare your Journey



I am going to the Australian Open!
The Australian Open is the place where the best tennis players in the world come to play.



Sometimes the Australian Open is called the AO. At the AO, there will be tennis matches to watch as well as lots of other activities.



When I arrive at the Ball Park session at 7:30am I will meet at the City Entrance and enter at 8am.

My best way to get here is to Uber/Train/Drive to federation square and walk down to the entrance





I will go to the entrance once I have received my accreditation (hard card on lanyard). I will then have a security person check inside my bag.



I might also have a security person scan me with a handheld security wand. This makes sure that everyone only brings safe things into the AO.

I will then have my accreditation scanned and walk through before handing my accreditation back to AO staff.



Once I have lined up, I can play on the Emirates Explorers & Little Travellers (a tricycle baggage drop activity and luggage tag art station).



Once I have lined up, I can play on the Hot Shots HQ Mini Tennis Courts and Skills Garden



If I have my bathers, I can head into our water zone and head down the 4-lane waterslide.



I can play with my family in Dunlop Down the Line where the aim of the game is to hit 4 tennis balls into a horizontal or diagonal row before your opponent can



I can test my serve accuracy, hit tennis balls in the different scored tubes to accumulate the highest total score at Coloured Ball Target Practice



If I need a break I
can go to the
sensory room.





If I need to use the toilet, I can look for a sign or ask a staff member to direct me.



The weather may be hot. If I get hot I can cool down in the misters or get a drink of water.



If I need help or advice, there are many people wearing yellow shirts and holding an umbrella who can help me.
