Neurodivergent people make up an estimated 15 to 20% of the population – your colleagues, clients and customers. One-third of Australian organisations identify neuroinclusion as a priority, but most don't have the tools to act on it.

An engineer who had lost confidence received three job offers after working with an Amaze specialist advisor. An academic, exhausted from years of masking, found support to sustain her future employment. A woman returning from a caring career break identified her transferable skills and secured a new role.

These are individual stories, but the ripple effect goes much further. We all benefit from a neuroinclusive future.
